\$25 entry fee per contestant, payable to the Warren County A & L Fair to be paid with submission of Entry form. No refunds for contestant who drops out of the contest for any reason.

RULES:

- 1. Contestants must be residents of Warren County for at least six months.**
2. Contestants must be 5 years old but not older than 6 years on the day of the contest.
3. Dresses must be below the knee. If floor length, please hem to above the tip of the shoe, contestants will walk up and down stairs backstage.
4. Contestants will attend rehearsal or forfeit the right to participate in the pageant.
5. Optional newspaper picture, published in the Southern Standard, for an additional \$5 due at registration.
6. A child cannot be in both the entertainment and the pageant.
7. Committee members children will not be allowed to enter the pageant.
8. Previous Tiny Fairest winners may not recompete for the same title.
9. If a contestant becomes ill backstage and needs to leave, they forfeit their participation in the pageant.
10. ONE designated person will check the contestant in backstage, the same person must check them out.
