## **2025** Warren County A & L Fair Fairest of the Fair Pageant

- 1. All contestants must be a resident of Warren County for at least six months. Contestant must provide proof of residency to the pageant committee; this can be parents/guardians residence property tax document or a school documented paper with contestant address. This proof of residency is required at registration for each contestant to be entered into the pageant, failure to produce satisfactory proof of residency results in disqualification.
- 2. Contestant must be sponsored by one local club or business firm.
- 3. As of December 31, of this year, she must have reached her 16<sup>th</sup> but not her 21<sup>st</sup> birthday.
- 4. A contestant cannot qualify if she has ever been married, had a child, or been found guilty of a felony. If the contestant should marry during her year of reign, title and winnings are given to the first runner-up.
- 5. Contestants in pageant must be, and must have always been, of the female gender.
- 6. Dresses may be one or two pieces with NO midriff showing or high slits. Must be formal, floor length.
- 7. Contestants will be judged on: Beauty, poise and personality 75%, Interview 25%.
- 8. Contestants will have a short 2-minute interview with the judges on the morning of Saturday, September 6<sup>th</sup>, to be held at the Magnolia Room at 201 Locust Street. Judges are provided with a copy of the contestant's application.
- 9. There will be a non-refundable entry fee of \$25.00 per contestant payable to the Warren County A & L Fair. Fee will be paid with submission of entry form. This may be paid by the contestant or the sponsor. Cash or Checks will be accepted.
- 10. Judges will select a winner, first, second and third runner-up. The winner will represent Warren County in Tennessee's "Fairest of the Fairs" contest in January next year. Winner must be available to attend ALL functions of the Tennessee State Convention and Fairest of the Fairs contestant workshop. If unable to fulfill this obligation, she will relinquish her title, crown, and winnings. The alternate will represent Warren County in the state pageant and all other activities.
  - a. Winner receives a \$1,000.00 scholarship presented by Security Federal Savings Bank to be used at a college of her choice. If the winner does not attend college the first runner up will receive the scholarship.
- 11. The Warren County A & L Fair will pay the actual expenses of the winner and chaperone to the state contest. The chaperone accompanying contestant must be over 25 years of age and approved by the local pageant committee.
- 12. During the Fairest of the Fair contest, the contestant <u>will NOT</u> be allowed to have visitors. **NO Parents or any visitors**, any contestant with visitors' backstage will be disqualified.
- 13. No drugs, drinking or improper behavior will be tolerated and reason for disqualification.
- 14. All contestants will attend practice and abide by all the rules or forfeit the right to participate in the pageant.
